4. What did Jesus do for the first time? (14-15)
  - a. He told the people to be quiet.
  - b. He received and encouraged their praise.
  - c. He argued with the religious leaders.
  
5. According to the prophesy in Zechariah 9:9, the \_\_\_\_\_ would come riding on a donkey.
  
6. The religious leaders (Pharisees) were frustrated and said, “Look, the \_\_\_\_\_ has gone after him.” (19)
